Recently, graduates began an urban farm in their local church. They now hold community seminars to teach men and women in their community how to feed their families in **even the smallest space**. Community Seminars serve communities & give us a platform to share the gospel. In August 2023, **an entire group of community leaders from the Massai tribe came to know Jesus** through these seminars. One man wept and said, "I have carried shame my entire life, I never knew that I could experience forgiveness."

Small-scale farms are being started all throughout Tanzania as our students take the training they receive back to their own communities. Pastors are able to provide for their families, congregations, and communities through agricultural.

On top of a 200 acre rural farm, GM also has an Urban Farming Training Center in the city. Apollo Mazengo has written the first Swahili book instructing the layperson how to feed their families through small urban spaces. Our team is now providing training all throughout Tanzania.
