Since our last update, our team continues in our areas of ministry as well as the task to build up our farm. We have worked with those with farm experience to help us fix the water reservoir in order to retain water. Water equals life out there on the farm! We hired a company to dig a well, and even after a survey, all the drill hit were rocks. This disappointment of the well not working reminded us again that God is in control, nothing is a surprise to Him. We pray for April showers to bring rain so our fixed/upgraded water reservoir will hold water so we can continue with the crops we already have planted. This will bring profit to fund our growing ministry is a sustainable way here in Tanzania and allow our permits to be renewed.

While we make our plans, it is ultimately the Lord who ordains our steps. This brings us great comfort and peace. We are thankful to be seeing **salvations** in our ministries, **discipleship**, bible **training for local pastors** and **false doctrine being combated**.

Britt has had the chance to minister to two women and a baby coming from a Maasai village. The young mother had a horrible wound on her leg that was not healing with traditional medicine. This was dangerous to her own life, and impacting her ability to nurse and care for her young baby. The grandmother came as well to help support her grand-daughter and great-grandson as they are staying with us and getting medical treatment here in Dar. This allows easy opportunity for wound care, good nutrition and learning from each other. Our neighbors have ministered to them as well through prayer and giving solar-charged radios to hear the Bible read outloud. The clinic we have been visiting for medications and consults is a Christian Mission clinic where we talk about our Great Physician. We thank the Lord for this chance to help in a small way in this family's life as well as point to Jesus through what we say and do.

Also, Joseph Boon (Brit's medical ministry partner) has made several big trips this year to host gospel centered seminars in partnerships with local churches. Already in 2024, over 400 people have placed their faith in Jesus Christ and connected to a local church for discipleship. God is working!
