I pray that you have had a great summer. It is crazy to think school is starting back up and the summer break is gone. Thank you so much for supporting us. In July, we hit 7 years that God has allowed us to travel as Seedline missionaries. Thank you for your support whether it's financial or through prayer. It is very humbling that you support us, and we thank you as a family for you allowing us to do what we do.

We just finished up a 5 week travel stretch where we visited churches in Indiana, Tennessee, Pennsylvania, and Ohio doing scripture for a container which will supply scriptures to Togo, West Africa. I'm excited to work on another container for a national pastor who is doing a great work there. BPS is planning to send a container with 200,000 JRs, 9,000 WBs, and 9,000 NTs.

Our family will enjoy a short break before we start traveling again in September. Our next break will be around Thanksgiving. Pray for us as we will travel to churches in Missouri, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, Indiana, Ohio and to a Christian school in Kentucky. Pray for Quinn as he will start the first grade and will continue to do school on the road as we travel.

Please continue to pray for Quinn and Cam's health needs. Quinn has been doing well and will have a follow up neurology appointment in September. Cameron just had an orthopedic appointment which showed he does not have hemihypertrophy like we thought, but he has Trevor's disease. It is a rare disease where extra bone will grow in certain joints. This will require some attention in the next few years for Cameron that will result in possible surgeries. Because his condition has changed, we no longer have to have ultrasounds or blood draws. His risk for tumors or childhood cancer has gone down! Praise the Lord! We know God is in control and our trusting Him with our son's health. Please pray with us as we continue to navigate their health.
