# ←From This to This → in six weeks



While we were in Michigan the last week of April for my parents' memorial service, Kim had what we thought were severe allergies. On the morning of April 28th, Kim woke up and could not breathe. We called 911 and she was taken to the hospital in Chelsea, Michigan. It took them four hours to get Kim stabilized. It was not allergies but congestive heart failure.

On May 2nd Kim was transferred to St. Joe's hospital in Ann Arbor, Michigan for a Heart Cathe. It revealed no blockages and she was able to be treated with medicine.

Kim spent eight days in the hospital and six of those days she was on life support. Our question to the Cardiologist

was, "Will we be able to return to Mongolia?" The answer was not what we expected. He said, "Why not! You can do this. You need to recover from this episode and have blood work done weekly and watch the numbers."

We went from not sure if Kim was going to make it through the night to being in Mongolia in six short weeks! GOD IS SO GOOD!

I Peter 5:7 says, "Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you." It is so hard to cast ALL your cares on HIM. Psalm 55:22 says, "Cast thy burden upon the LORD, and he shall sustain thee: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved." He has sustained us through it all!
