Evangelistic Outreach ~ It was a real blessing to be able to spend the summer months serving in Alaska and Canada. I was able to partner with my Dad and our ministry team over the summer and during this time, we were able to work extensively in evangelism and personal work in Terrace and New Hazelton. We were also able to take numerous additional evangelism trips to outlying towns and villages including Kitimat, New Aiyansh, Glen Vowel, Kispiox and others. It was a fruitful time with many new contacts being made and many folks hearing the Gospel clearly, very often for the first time.



Special Meetings ~ Over the course of the summer, our team held several special revival services and outdoor meetings in the Terrace and Hazelton areas. The first revival meeting was held in New Hazelton. It was a real encouragement as the Lord richly blessed with wonderful services and good attendance with new visitors every service! We have even seen some of the folks continue to attend the regular services! Please continue to pray for the work there in Hazelton.

In September, my Dad and family hosted a revival meeting in Terrace. Dad invited Pastor Ken Parrett from Nova Scotia, Canada, to come and preach the revival as well as the outdoor meetings. During the days, we all went out and knocked doors and then gathered for the services each evening. The preaching, special music and fellowship were a real blessing and it was wonderful to see the Lord work and bless the seed sown with powerful services and good attendance! There were new visitors in each service and two individuals called on the Lord for salvation. One of these is a young man named Robert. The other is my younger brother, Joel. Praise the Lord! We are thankful for what the Lord is doing in Terrace and ask that you continue to pray for the mission work there!

Aviation ~ It was a blessing to be able to help again this year with the missions flight camp in Wisconsin. The Wings as Eagles ministry out of Wyldewood Baptist Church hosts this camp for young men every year. The purpose of the week long camp is to challenge these young men on the importance of listening to the Lord and surrendering to his call for their lives, whatever that might be. For me, it was a great opportunity to use my Flight Instructor certificate and keep my flying and teaching experience current. I logged around 17 hours of flight time that week, giving flight lessons to these 16 young men. It was also a blessing to be able to teach in the missions classes there at the camp. Pray that the Lord will use the time spent with these young men to impact their lives and bear lasting fruit.



Deputation Trails ~ As of the beginning of October, I am now back on the road traveling on deputation in churches here in the states. It has been a blessing to be able to share the ministry with several churches and pastors so far. It is encouraging to see others catch the vision and burden for reaching the remote towns and villages in Alaska and Canada with the Gospel. I have more meetings coming up and am working to fill my schedule on into the coming year.
