

The Road Home Orphanage

As you know, we work with children in the orphanage who are abandoned by their parents. Some are orphaned because of the war in Ukraine; though, most are Moldovan children who had parents, but for whatever reason have been rejected by

them. Please pray as we work with these broken children. The last several months have been tragic. Three of the girls that were saved committed suicide. The last one, Ana, hung herself. We were in shock and never saw any signs of her going in this direction. Many of the children simply hide behind their true feelings. Many of them have been hurt deeply because of being rejected. Please pray. Right now there is an on-going police investigation into why the children committed suicide. Please pray for us as we minister to them, and pray God would open our eyes to how we can help them through the Word of God.

We were also able to get much needed humanitarian supplies to those suffering in many of the nearby villages.

Since our last letter we have printed 19,950 books and 38,600 tracts. <u>Pray for revival later in the summer here in the villages of Rekoria, Alonesh, and Ternava.</u>
