- 2. According to verse 3, Who was Obadiah and what does it say about his relationship to God?
- 3. According to verse 5, Who did Obadiah hide in a cave?
- 4. According to verses 9-14, Why was Obadiah afraid Ahab would slay him?
- 5. According to verse 17, What did Ahab accuse Elijah of doing?
- 6. According to verse 22, How many prophets of Baal were there?
- 7. According to verse 24, What challenge did Elijah put forth?
- 8. According to verse 27, What was Elijah doing to the prophets of Baal?
- 9. According to verse 28, What were the prophets of Baal doing?
- 10. According to verse 31, How many stones did Elijah use to build his Altar?
- 11. According to verse 33-34, How many total barrels of water did Elijah pour on the altar?
- 12. According to verse 37, What were the two requests of Elijah's prayer?
- 13. According to verse 40, What happened to the prophets of Baal?
- 14. According to verse 43, How many times did Elijah tell his servants to look toward the sea?
- 15. According to verse 44, How did they describe the little cloud from the Sea?

Discussion: This is a great story to discuss the relationship between serving God and following a multitude to do evil.
