We filled in at the Belleville Michigan National Strawberry Festival June 14th, 15th, and 16th. Metro Baptist Church, Pastor Vaprezan allowed us to present AGM and the church members gave of their time and money to help in the booth. Also, two members of our home church came to help relieve us during this three-day festival. We are Praising the Lord for the profession of faith of 20 souls for His reward and glory and handing out over 600 tracts. Praying these tracts will bring them into the flock. What a great blessing is was to be home to take part in the mission work week. We give Him all the praise!
