Thank you, Pastor's for allowing us to attend your services and present AGM. I would like to add that the booth for Marlette Country Fair was canceled due unforeseen circumstances.

July 18th - We left for Bible Baptist Church in Charlevoix, MI to work the Venetian Festival. This booth was canceled due to unforeseen circumstances. I did have the privilege to preach and share AGM on the 18th in the evening service during their Camp Meeting which they have hosted for the past 29 years. This Camp Meeting was held from 7/21 – 7/25. A great meeting with several evangelists and pastors preaching and singing which stirred and blessed our hearts. August 1st - we traveled back to Chelsea to work the Jackson County Fair in Jackson, MI from 4th - 10th. Having five workers to help in the booth from Faith Baptist Church, Chelsea MI. We are so thankful and blessed to have great workers to help. The Lord worked mightily with us seeing 131 professions of faith and passed out 639 tracts. We are so thankful and give all the Glory to Him. Giving all the informational slips to the nearest IFBC in the area to follow up on. Each person upon salvation receives a ten-lesson discipleship booklet and other reading materials to help them understand what happened and what to do next.

Aug 12th - Arriving in Interlochen, MI to help work a booth for a couple of days with our very good friends Brother Rick and Sister Cindy Scott at the Buckley Old Engine Show in Buckley, MI. We made a quick stop to see our family in the Brown City and then headed to Westland, MI staying at Prayer Baptist Church, Pastor Greg McFadden. We had workers from Prayer Baptist as well Pastor Greg, who were very enthused working the booth. There were 21 professions faith and 1,155 tracts passed out. Praise the Lord for His Grace and Power! We found this area to have harden hearts and not interested in hearing the Gospel. God forgive them as they know not what they do. Pray that the tracts will soften hearts.
