New Full-Time Pastoral Intern—Rubio

Our fourth church plant, Cross Baptist, added a pastoral intern in August, Rubio Zhangjian. He and his wife Joy surrendered to full-time ministry and left their jobs to begin training and take up a post at Cross Baptist. Since then, God has brought their friends to hear the gospel, and we are beginning to see a core of regulars come to services.

New Church Plant in New City

Earlier this year, my nephew and niece Adam and Ashley Walz, returned to Taiwan from a short furlough and started a new church in Taichung, Candlestick Baptist.

New Preacher's Monthly Fellowship

This year our churches created a monthly fellowship meeting, led by pastors Peyton and Sam. Our fellowship shares a standard for future church planting ministry if the Lord would be pleased to continue to bless. Our vision for Kaohsiung remains to be 25 church plants in our city. In May of this year, our fellowship visited church planters in Cambodia for the first time. Our men came back to Taiwan with burdens for missions and our churches began supporting these church plants across the water.

New Church Plant—Second Mile Baptist Qishan Gospel Center

Finally, at the end of November, Pastor Sam and his men from Second Mile Baptist took the initiative to start a 5th church plant out of a former “preaching point” in Qishan. The man Sam has been training for ministry this is Brother Jiang “Zero”. They meet in Qishan (about a 40 minute drive) weekly for fellowship.
