Many of you frequently ask about **Rebekah's teaching certification paperwork**. As you might know, this has been in process now for at least 8 years. We recently received word that her petition was being analyzed; then we were asked to pay the fee and set up an appointment in Montevideo. We went June 18th. Rebekah must get other documents done (in her maiden name), but once submitted, the office workers committed to "facilitating things" since most of the difficult work has been done on the case. We pray this is the light at the end of the tunnel after all this time! Please join us in praying that this would really go through, and **Rebekah would be granted her teaching certificate here!**



With two, almost three, teenagers in the house, we are now navigating through a different stage of life as a family. (Steven is now 16 and in 11<sup>th</sup> grade, Zac is 14 in 9<sup>th</sup>, Hannah is 12 in 7<sup>th</sup>, and Tabi is 10 years old and in 5<sup>th</sup> grade.) We are constantly reminded as parents to watch and pray for their souls in this wicked world.
