A very unique thing happened last month while onboard a ship named Jps Afroditi. We had a visitor from Kentucky who was seeing the ministry for the first time as we boarded the ship. We came at a very convenient time when most of the crew was in the mess room for a break. The gift bags we brought were taken before we knew it and there arose an opportunity to speak to most of these men. After giving a brief witness to all who were listening, I could tell some had guestions that they wanted to ask. Apparently, there was a man onboard who seemed to be religious, so a lot of questions were thrown his way in the past. One question that they asked was, How can we know that the Bible is true? I think everyone needs to ask that question and, more importantly, find the answer to that question. After explaining that the God who cannot lie, decided to communicate to us through the scripture and that He used human instruments to give us His words, they didn't ask any more questions.
